## 1. PPT presentation on Wild life sanctuaries of Himachal Pradesh

The EBSB club members of St. Mary's College, Thrissurpresented PPT about 4 major wild life sanctuaries namely, Manali wild life sanctuary, Kais wild life sanctuary, Churdhar wildlife sanctuary and Kanwar wild life sanctuary in detail on July 20,2021. The dense forest, valleys and rivers make Himachal Pradesh ideal for wildlife to thrive. There are almost 40 wildlife sanctuaries in the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh. The detailing included geographical area, biogeographical realm, ecosystem including flora and fauna, and other major attractions.
