Establishment of IIC at our institution



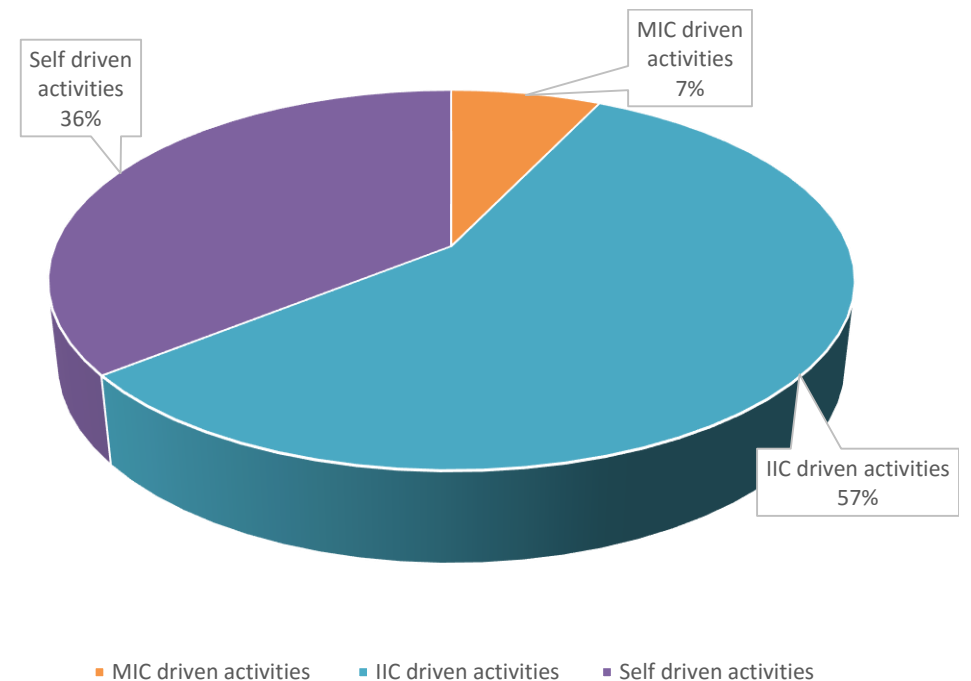
- ❖ Institution's Innovation Council at St. Mary's College Thrissur was established on 11th September 2019 as per the norms and regulations of MIC, MHRD

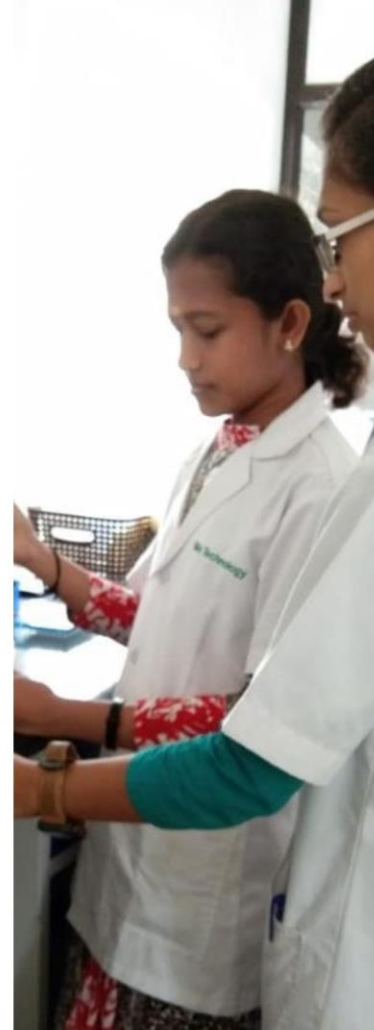

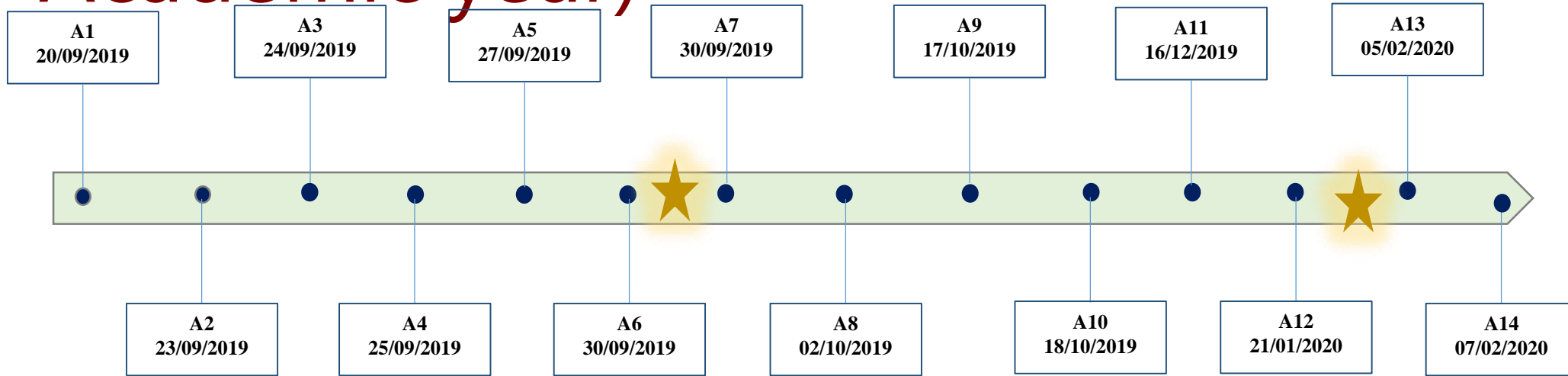
