#### Department Activities

- Department of social work performed a street play on the topic “Cancer”, at DBCLC, Bishop House, Thrissur on 14/6/2017. The programme was about to create awareness among School children and to create a cancer awareness group in schools (Lavender Army). Second year BSW students were performed in the play.

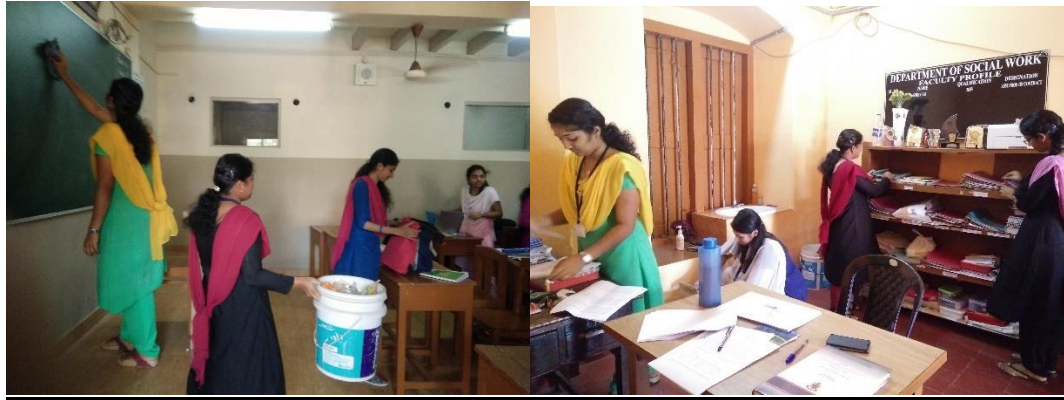
Butterfly Garden
