## **Observation of Environment Day**

Second semester BSW students performed a Flashmob at Kanjani bus stand premises and distributed brochures on prevention of drug abuse. Ms. Hyma K M was staff in charge and 20 students participated in the same.





## **AUGUST 2022**

## **Conducted a class on Prevention of Drug Abuse**

The students (Three students –III BSW) of Department of Social Work conducted a class on 'Prevention of Drug Abuse' at Kechery Anganwadi (ICDS – Chowannur Block) on 4<sup>th</sup> August 2022. About 42 adolescents were participated in the class. The class covered the areas like signs, risk factors and effects of substance use. The session started with an ice breaking session followed by specific areas of drug abuse with charts, posters and flash cards. The interaction session came to an end with clarification of doubts.



#### **Conducted survey on Extreme Poverty Eradication**

Department of Social Work in collaboration with Kolazhy GramPanchayath conducted a survey on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022 for finding extreme poverty families or impoverished families. First they got a training session and the questionnaire was analysed. Data were collected directly from the families.30 students were participated in the survey and collected data from 12 wards. The analysis, Interpretation and presentation of survey results were also done by the students.



## A talk on Women Empowerment and Prevention of Atrocities

Department of Social Work conducted a talk on 'Women Empowerment and Prevention of Atrocities' in collaboration with Sakhi One Stop Center, Irinjalakuda, a component of the umbrella scheme for the National Mission for Empowerment of Women that also encompasses the Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahayog Yojana. The programme was held on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2022 at 10.am. The session was handled by Ms. Sreelakshmi, Counsellor, Sakhi One Stop Center, Irinjalakuda focused on the areas like domestic violence, rape, sexual offences, acid attack, legislations for women etc..

## One day Conference on 'Youth Empowerment, Paradigms and Perspectives'




## **Awareness Class on HIV – AIDS**


## **Observation Visit**
