Workshop on RDBMS

On 9th Dec 2015 to 11th Dec 2015 the Department conducted a three day Workshop on RDBMS Project for our 3rd Semester Software Development students. The workshop is conducted in collaboration with Aitrich Technologies, Thrissur who is our Industrial Partner also. The workshop focused on the RDBMS part in an enterprise software application environment. The classes were handled by a team of four members under the leadership of Mr. Nithin George (Senior Developer, Aitrich Technologies).

Through the project,

- Made the students to do Requirement Analysis, and objective definition of the database.
- Take the students through the process of producing a detailed data model.
- Take the students through further steps such as gather, design & organize data in tables, specify the relationships & apply other constraints, normalize, etc.
- Apply different RDBMS best practices with security, performance, scalability and maintainability in focus with stored procedures, functions, views, etc.

Our students were divided into 5 Groups and each group is assigned a project. There are 5 different applications.

The 5 different applications are:

- E-com portal
- Manufacturer software system - where it takes care of production.
- Retailer's billing & inventory management
- Payment gateway - Enter the credit card number and validate the credit limit, deduct the amount from the account.
- Courier software - Give them the order information with contact\delivery details with weight of the products.

The above Project was planned as follows

- Requirement gathering and estimation (rough)
- Team members, roles & responsibilities
- Task break down
- Data test cases (and other related documents and diagrams)

The above task is subdivided into

- Requirement analysis
- Define objectives
- Data modeling
- Approval
- Organize in tables
- Apply constraints
- Database Programming

By the end of the workshop the team members get knowledge & development experience using best practices in RDBMS. They also get to understand and apply the different important factors to be considered in each steps of database design and management, considering even the nonfunctional features such as security, performance, maintainability, and scalability.



One Day Seminar (B.Voc Multimedia)

The one day seminar on “Animation & VFX Technology” was successfully organized by the Department of Vocational Studies for Multimedia Students on 12th November 2015. Smt. Deepa K C delivered the welcome speech. The Seminar was chaired by Mr.Jithin K U, VFX Team Leader form ERAM Animation Lab, Kochi. It was an interactive session to the students with following topics:
