Breakthrough Science Society members, staff, non-teaching staff and students of our college were present at the time of inauguration.

The basic objective of the Photographic Exhibition on "Biography of Madam Curie" is to inspire students to the excitement of creative pursuit of science and attract talent to the study of science and thus build the required critical human resource pool for strengthening and expanding the science system.

Marie Curie is an icon in the history of science. As the lone woman in a male world, her life story is almost as groundbreaking as her discoveries. Marie Curie received the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1903 and became the first woman to be awarded a Nobel Prize. In 1911, she was awarded the full Nobel Prize in Chemistry and thus became the first person ever to be confrerred the award a second time. The exhibition tries a new approach to the story of Marie Curie.
