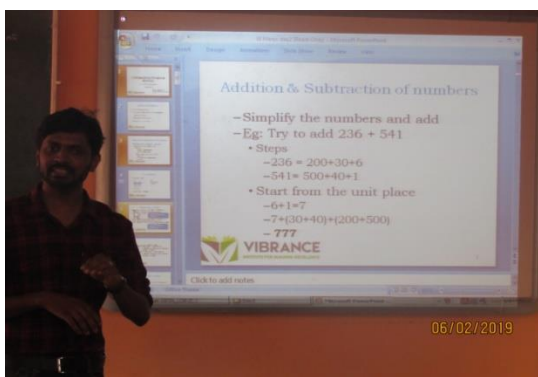
Martyrs Day
