Dr.Bindu Ann Philip Head of the Department of English felicitated the gathering.

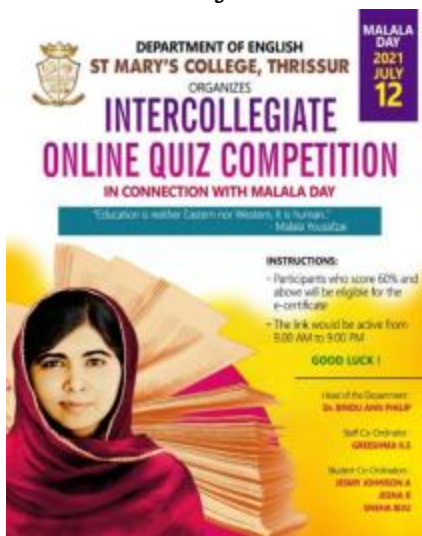

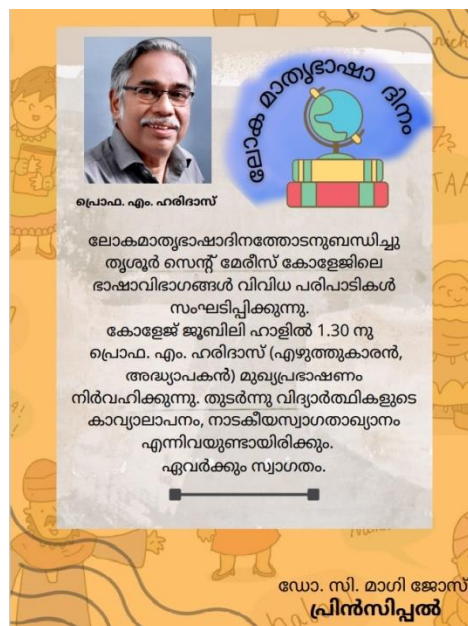
➤ **ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION**

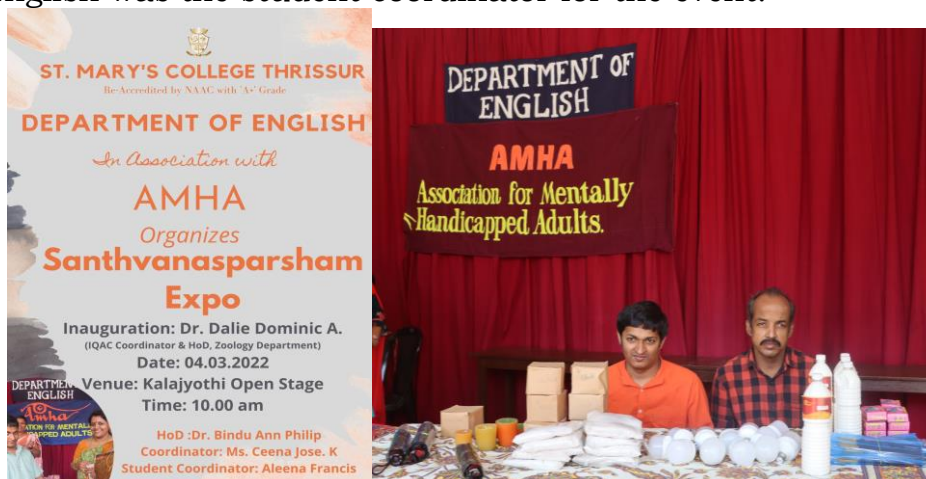
➤ **WONDER WOMAN CONTEST**
