

<u>DAY 5</u>




Later on "Debate Foe" a debate session was also organized and made familiarity with online classes.

A CLASS ON GOODS AND SERVICE TAX (GST)



A TALK ON CANCER AWARNESS






CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAMME
