The two day seminar included various talks on microbial biodiversity and use of microbes for bioremediation, biofertilizers, bioesticides, waste management etc. by various dignitaries from academic as well as scientific communities, and oral and poster presentations by researchers, faculty and students. The best papers were awarded in the Valedictory session which was chaired by Dr. Binod Parameswaran, Scientist, Division of Biotechnology, NIIST (CSIR), Trivandrum.

We, the students of St. Mary's college celebrated this auspicious day by cleaning our college premises. The programme began at 9.00 am with prayer. Our principal Dr. Sr. Chrislin inaugurated the programme. He elaborated on different waste management techniques with special emphasis on composting. He explained about different types of composting such as pit composting, pipe compost, vermicompost, biogas plant, thumboor muzhi compost, biobin etc. This interesting and informative session was followed by an interactive session where he clarified the doubts of the students.



The Department of Microbiology initiated tube composting to make use of our college food waste. Shredded newspapers and food wastes were added to the tube compost set up followed by the addition saw dust, soil and dried cow dung. The Department also initiated pot composting method to prepare manure for our roof top garden.
