#### Microbiology Association Activities (2019-2020)

Microbiology Association Activities of the academic year 2019-2020 was initiated with World Environment Day celebrations on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2019. In connection with World Environment Day, Department organised an awareness programme on Monsoon Diseases –Prevention and Control Measures. #### 1. Announcement of Monsoon tips in connection with World Environment Day

Monsoon tips included the signs, symptoms, identification tests, preventive measures, routes of transmission of various diseases including Dengue, Chikungunya, Malaria, Dysentry, Typhoid, Cholera, etc. Also tips on the recently emerged threatening disease, Nipah was also given. General measures of hygiene and food safety habits were also the part of announcement. Announcements were continued till 14/ June /2019.

#### 3. Monsoon awareness programme at Anchery and ValarkkavuAnganwady
