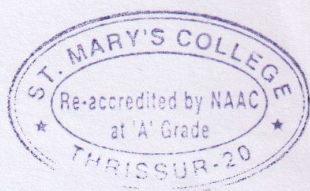
Respondent Group - Faculty UG and PG

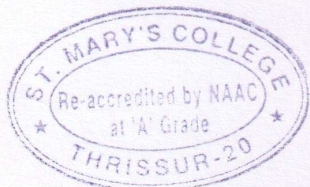
