#### **Guidance for Entrance Preparation by Department of Chemistry**

Department of Chemistry provided orientation for competitive examinations for III DC students. #### **Competitive Exam Coaching by Department of Computer Science and Applications**

Department of Computer Science and Applications conducted competitive examination coaching classes for all second year BCA degree students. 15 classes are taken each year wise and students collected the questions and discussed in each classes. Questions are based on General Knowledge, Aptitude, reasoning, Group discussion etc.




#### **Competitive Examination Guidance by Department of Management Studies**

Department of Management Studies has been conducting competitive exam guidance class for the final year students from 2016 onwards. Classes were provided by the faculty of the Department itself. The session is conducting in the 4<sup>th</sup> hour (zero hour). As per competitive examination for MBA admission predetermined syllabus is following in the class. The same has been allotted to faculties of the department. Coaching was provided to 36 students in 2018-19 academic year.

#### **NET Coaching by Department of Biotechnology**

NET coaching classes were given by Dr. Saritha Francis to M.Sc Biotechnology students. A total of 24 students attended the classes. Of this 8 students appeared the CSIR-UGC NET examination.



#### **NET Coaching by Department of History**

As a part of giving guidance for competitive examinations to students, Dept. of History organized NET coaching classes for various PG students from 10<sup>th</sup> October onwards in association with the Brilliance College Thrissur. 21 PG students attended this training programme.



#### **NET Coaching by Department of Mathematics**

The Department of Mathematics offers NET coaching in Mathematics every year which is open to students of other colleges too. In this academic year, it started on December 2018. The classes were scheduled on all Saturdays, Sundays and Public holidays and were lead by Dr. Sajeev S Nair, Asst. Professor, Govt. Engineering College, Thrissur and Ms. Sukanya K.P, Research Scholar, Dept. of Mathematics, St. Mary's College, Thrissur. 21 students attended the class.



#### **NET Coaching by Department of Commerce**

From 17 to 21 December Commerce Department conducted an intensive Net Coaching class for M.com students. It was a 30 hours coaching session which was handled by Greeshma P B, our alumnae, Faculty members Jinu Josy, Sneha Silvester, Femy Moni, Delma Pulikkottil D and Anjani Antony also led the session. The major aim of the class was to enable the students to compete in National Eligibility Test with their full potential. The class — covers all the topic related to general paper and commerce.



#### **Finishing School Report by Department of Economics**

A two-day Finishing School Programme was organized by the Department of Economics on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2019 with a tie up with Vibrance Academy, Thrissur. 50 students attended the session. Hands on Practice and mock interview was arranged .There were 4 session - Analytical & Logical Reasoning, Aptitude – Maths & Basic Numerical skills, Reading comprehension and Data Interpretation.



#### Competitive Exam Coaching by Career Guidance and Placement Cell

Career Guidance Cell conducted competitive examination coaching classes for all second year degree students of this college during their third semester on every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 2.20-3.15 pm. Students were categorized into six groups as: BCom and BBA, BSW and English, Chemistry and Botany, BCA and Mathematics, History and Economics, Microbiology and Biotechnology.

These six classes were handled by subject experts from different departments. The topics covered were: GK, Current Affairs, Mathematics, Reasoning and English. Along with these topics, the classes offer valuable tips on how to crack such entrance exams. The classes are conducted in such a manner that students are able to grasp the facts spoken with improved speed and accuracy. Tricky questions which are seen in every aptitude test, problems, and problems related to direction, pattern matching and solving, blood relation questions, scientific names, Indian Constitution, study of various sciences etc. were involved in order to enhance the students' perspective of the exam and also to improve their answering capabilities.
