



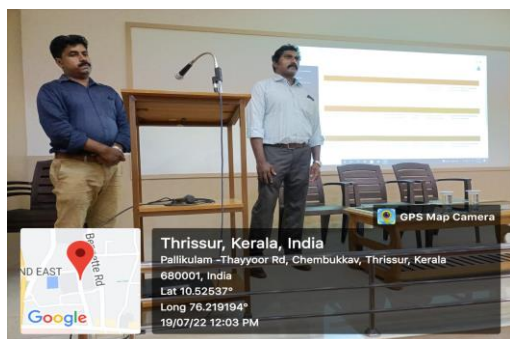

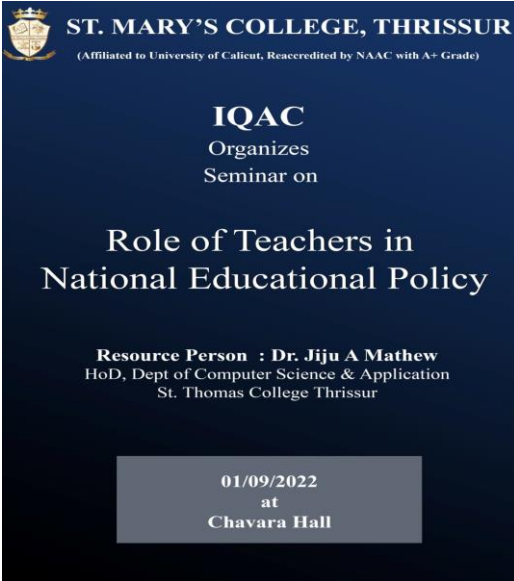

Sr. Dr. Rani George Endowment International Seminar

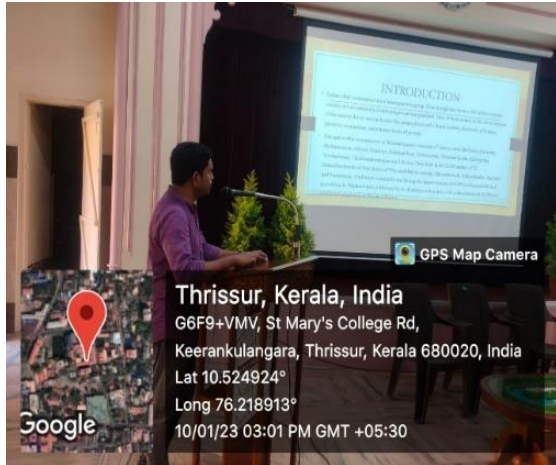

and Ms. Anuja J (Associate Professor, Department of Political Science Vimala College, Thrissur). Paper presentations were also conducted in connection with the seminar.

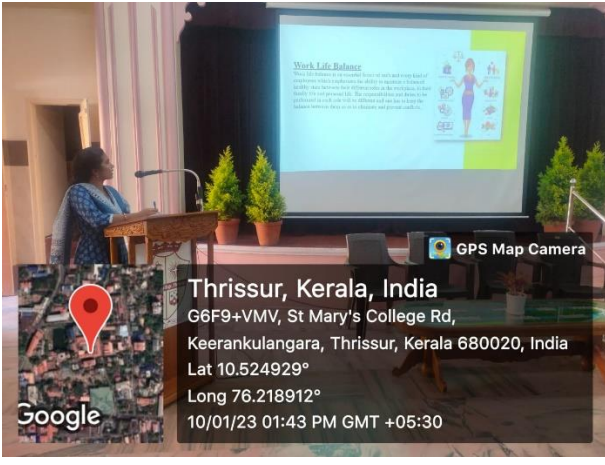

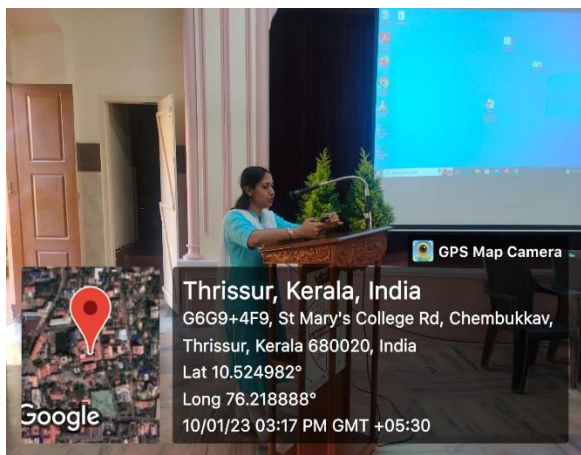
Paper Presentations for faculty, research scholars and students was also organized.

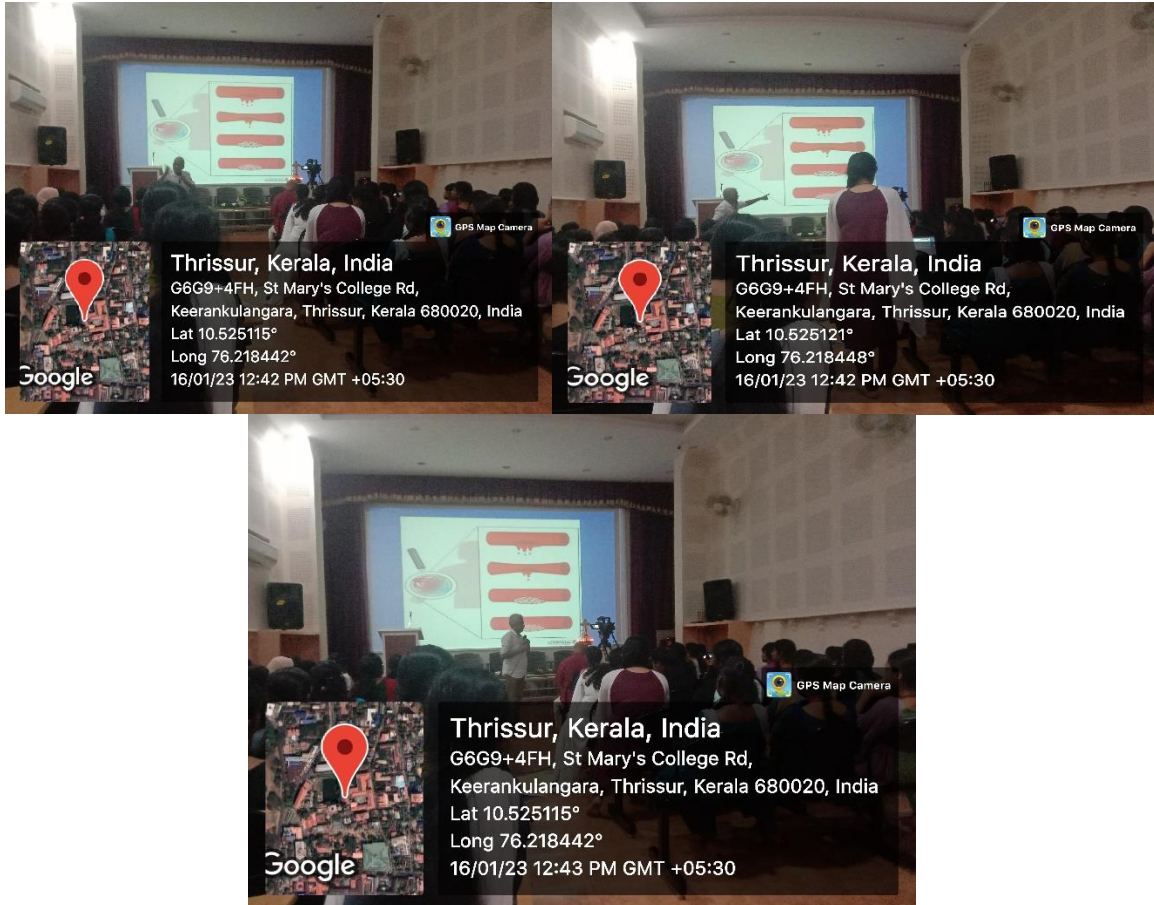

Seminar on Navigating PCOD in day to day life


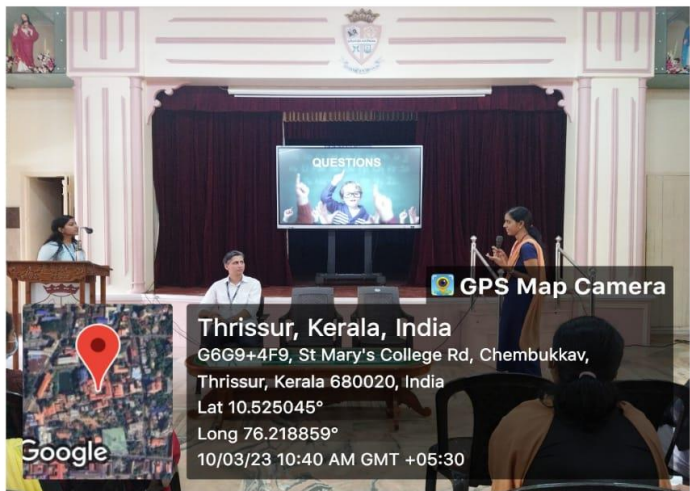

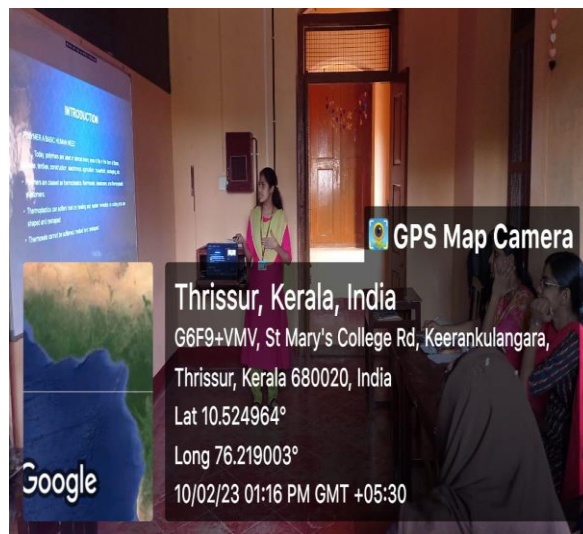
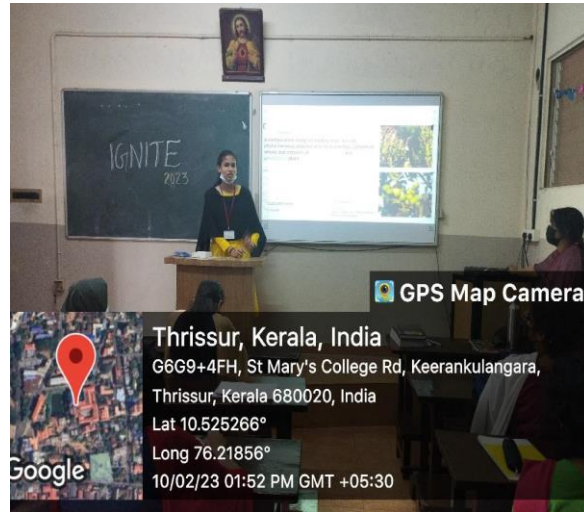
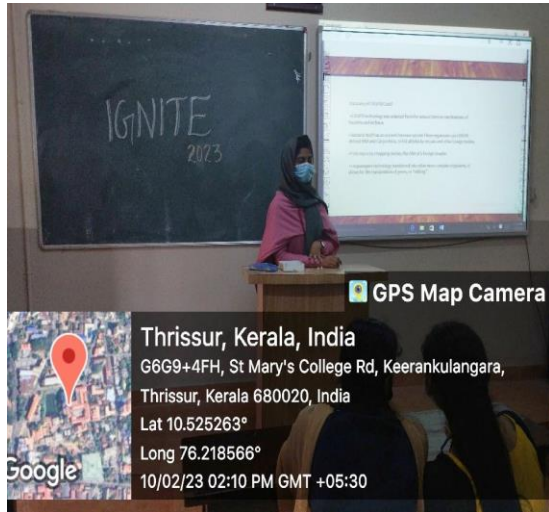
Spectrum

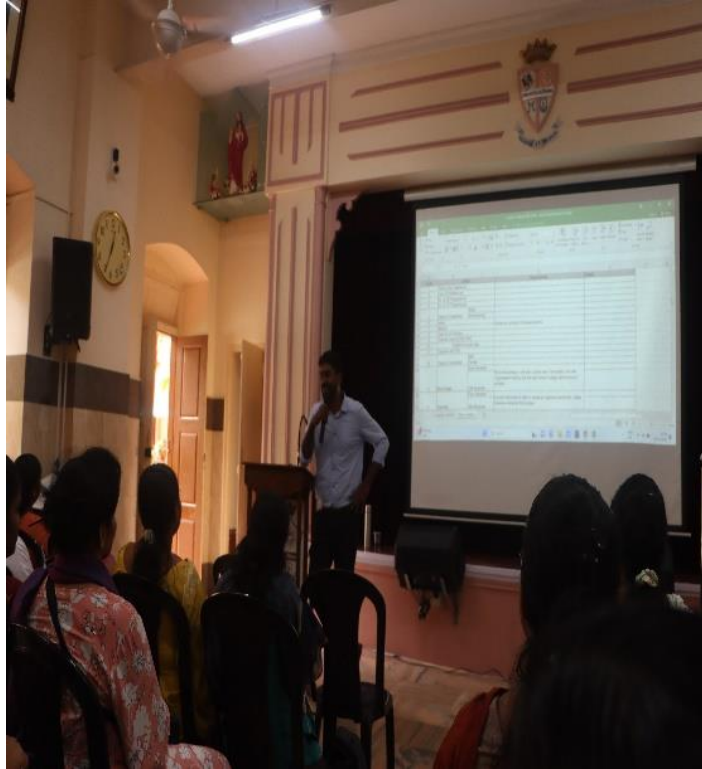
Faculty Development Programme on Academic Strategic Planning
