- To encourage the students to ‘earn while learn’, new Add On and Certificate Courses have been planned.
- As suggested by the NAC Peer team, the college is aiming at the maximum utilization and expansion of the existing infrastructure.
- As a strong alumna is an asset to the institution, the college is devising ways to strengthen the alumna of the college.
- The IQAC is planning to organize a NAAC sponsored seminar on “Quality enhancement in Higher Education through Student Support and Progression” for faculty, students and parents.
