



Alumnae Feedback on Curriculum (2023-2024)



The feedback was collected department-wise from alumni who have visited the Campus during the academic year 2023-24. The consolidated feedback was analyzed by IQAC using the Likert Scale. The satisfaction index was classified into five heads 0-20, 20-40, 40-60, 60-80, and 80-100. The respondents of previous years are considered.
